Dr. Don Church Scholarship for Agriculture or Veterinary Medicine

Do you reside in Red Deer County and have chosen to pursue a degree in Agriculture or Veterinary Medicine? We have a scholarship opportunity for you.

The Dr. Don Church Scholarship was established to provide the amount of \$2,000 to be awarded to a resident of Red Deer County who will be, or is currently enrolled in a post-secondary degree program focusing on Agriculture or Veterinary Medicine. **Two \$2,000 scholarships are distributed annually.**

Conditions of Eligibility: The applicant must meet the following criteria to be eligible to apply for this award:

- ✓ High School Diploma received from a Central Alberta High School
- ✓ Permanent residence must be Red Deer County
- ✓ Individuals enrolled in full-time or part-time studies and working towards a degree in Agriculture or Veterinary Medicine at an accredited post-secondary institution
- ✓ Demonstrated leadership or community involvement as evidenced by a resume prepared by the applicant or a reference letter
- ✓ Consideration may also be given to the financial need of the applicant

Application: The application must include:

- ✓ Completed application form
- ✓ A current resume (including community achievements)
- ✓ Documentation from the educational institute confirming your acceptance and registration in the program (student ID number)

Submission Date: A fully completed application must be received by **June 28, 2019**.
