The Red Deer & District Community Foundation is an independent, community-based organization that focuses on philanthropy, grants and leadership.

We work closely with our donors to invest in the people, projects and activities that continue to build and strengthen our communities by identifying long term needs and opportunities and focusing on sustainable solutions.

[how we do it]

As a charitable organization, we prudently invest the donations we receive in an endowment. Each year we disburse the income we make on that investment to charitable organizations and projects.

Presently we have \$15.2 million in pooled assets. The larger our pool grows, the more money we have to respond to the needs within our communities.

And because we never touch the principle, there will always be granting dollars available for Central Alberta charities.

[where we've been]

The Foundation has been around since 1989 and has granted over \$11.5 million to charitable projects within Central Alberta.

We are considered a 360° grant maker because we work to ensure community needs are covered in all sectors of society including arts & culture, health & wellness, human services, recreation, sport, education and the environment.

Since 2015 our endowment has grown from \$12.7 million to \$15.2 million and more than \$1,550,000 has been given in grants in the last *three* years.

As we wrap up our 30th year as a Community Foundation, we will be working to determine the challenges our district faces and strategizing on how we can address these issues.

The Red Deer & District Community Foundation Board of Directors is committed to raising the Foundation's profile within the community, expanding our unrestricted funding pool and creating granting opportunities that serve as a gateway of change for our district.
